San Francisco man fatally shot in Oakland

A San Francisco man was fatally shot in Oakland on Saturday night, police said.

The shooting occurred about 10:30 p.m. in the area of East 17th Street near 13th Avenue. The ShotSpotter gunfire detection system alerted officers to the shooting, police said.

Officers found a 28-year-old man suffering from at least one gunshot wound about four blocks away, on 14th Avenue near East 21st Street, police said. The victim was taken to a hospital, where he died. His name was not released, pending family notifications.

Homicide detectives are investigating the circumstances of the shooting. The gunfire erupted after the victim got into a dispute with another person, the East Bay Times [reported](#).
